Next Sunday, May 19, we will take up a second collection for Holy Family Hospital, a state-of-the-art maternity and neonatal critical care

center serving poor and at-risk women, infants, and children just 1,500 steps from the birthplace of Christ. The Hospital is a beacon of hope for families in the Bethlehem region.

Holy Family Hospital is the only hospital in the region that can care for and deliver babies under 32 weeks, where some preemies can weigh as little as a pound. Holy Family Hospital delivers almost 5,000 babies every year. The Hospital is an oasis of peace and serves 40,000 women each year through the main hospital and the clinics in refugee camps in the Judean Desert. The ongoing economic fallout from the COVID lockdown is compounded by the current war in the Holy Land, bringing Bethlehem's economy to a near halt when stability is needed most. Courage International, Inc., is an apostolate of the Roman Catholic Church which offers pastoral support to men and women experiencing same-sex attractions who have chosen to live a chaste life. Founded in 1980 by Fr. John

Harvey, OSFS, at the request of the late Terence Cardinal Cooke, it has since expanded to over 175 Courage chapters worldwide. On November 28, 2016, Courage International, received canonical status in the Roman Catholic Church as a diocesan clerical public association of the faithful, making it the only canonically-approved apostolate of its kind.

5 Goals of Courage

- 1. To live chaste lives in accordance with the Roman Catholic Church's teaching on homosexuality;
- 2. To dedicate our entire lives to Christ through service to others, spiritual reading, prayer, meditation, individual spiritual direction, frequent attendance at Mass, and the frequent reception of the sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist;
- 3. To foster a spirit of fellowship in which we may share with one another our thoughts and experiences, and so ensure that no one will have to face the problems of homosexuality alone;
- 4. To be mindful of the truth that chaste friendships are not only possible but necessary in a chaste Christian life; and to encourage one another in forming and sustaining these friendships;
- 5. To live lives that may serve as good examples to others

VINCENTIAN GOOD WORKS

Ms. Jennifer is a 65 year-old, disabled, former hairdresser living in Atlanta whose family dates back to the late 1800's. In fact, Ms. Jennifer lives alone in her grandparent's shot-gun cabin not too far from the church. You won't see the cabin from the main road as it's tucked in a wooded lot behind some nice homes. The cabin has no A/C nor insulation. Ms. Jennifer lives on Social Security disability of \$944/ month and receives \$170 in food stamps. Vincentians from Holy Spirit have been helping her and her mother, who has since passed, since 2008. She has been like family, as we visit with her 3-4 times a year to assist with a utility bill or a Publix gift card. More recently her requests have become more frequent. This year we developed a plan with a budget for her to use available resources like food pantries and MARTA Mobility, replace her \$60 a month land line with a low-cost cell phone, and to save her limited resources. We are now walking with our friend to help her stick to this plan and to become more financially independent. This is yet another example how the wonderful Vincentians of Holy Spirit help
