

Robert Hugh Benson's (1871-1914) *Lord of the World* has been called prophetic by both Pope Benedict XVI and Pope Francis. Benson, descended from a long line of Anglican clergymen, began writing this work two years after his 1903 conversion to the Catholic faith. In this novel of the Antichrist, set in a

fictional universe, Monsignor Benson accurately predicts interstate highways, weapons of mass destruction, the use of aircraft to drop bombs on both military and civilian targets, and passenger air travel in advanced Zeppelins.

Por lo tanto, «todo esto» es, principalmente el misterio de Cristo, Dios que se ha hecho cercano a nosotros. Esto implica otra dimensión: Cristo nunca está solo; él vino entre nosotros, murió solo, pero resucitó para atraer a todos hacia sí. Cristo, como dice la Escritura, se crea un cuerpo, reúne a toda la humanidad en su realidad de la vida inmortal. Y así, en Cristo, que reúne a la humanidad, conocemos el futuro de la humanidad: la vida eterna. De manera que todo esto

es muy sencillo, en definitiva: conocemos a Dios conociendo a Cristo, su cuerpo, el misterio de la Iglesia y la promesa de la vida eternal".
