





Rosary Sale to Benefit Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem



The war in the Holy Land has made the plight for Christians living there even more difficult than usual.

This weekend volunteers from past Holy Land pilgrimages and members of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre are selling olive wood rosary beads after all Masses.

The proceeds from the sales will go to the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem to provide essential support

and financial assistance, primarily to the Christian community in the Holy Land. The rosary beads are \$10 each. Cash is preferred, but Venmo and checks made payable to "Archdiocese of Atlanta" will be accepted. Donations above and beyond the rosary sales are also appreciated. The Archdiocese of Atlanta is working in partnership with the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem in this fundraising effort. Thank you, in advance, for your generosity.




GREAT BOOKS DISCUSSION GROUP

Robert Hugh Benson's (1871-1914) *Lord of the World* has been called prophetic by both Pope Benedict XVI and Pope Francis. Benson, descended from a long line of Anglican clergymen, began writing this work two years after his 1903 conversion to the Catholic faith. In this novel of the Antichrist, set in a

fictional universe, Monsignor Benson accurately predicts interstate highways, weapons of mass destruction, the use of aircraft to drop bombs on both military and civilian targets, and passenger air travel in advanced Zeppelins.



SOLEMNITY OF THE ANNUNCIATION OF THE LORD

The Annunciation recalls the day when the Archangel Gabriel appeared to Mary and revealed God's will that she become the Mother of the Son of God.


