The purpose of Vacation Bible School to share the love of Jesus with children. As a youth volunteer in Vacation Bible School, I'm making a commitment to be a servant of God and an example of His love to all kids and their families!

In order to bring glory to God during Vacation Bible School, I agree to:

• Focus on the youth – they are my purpose for assisting at VBS, not to catch up with my friends! I will stay in the area or with the group where I am assigned to work and focus on my assignment, not other youth.

• Turn off my cell phone and other electronics during VBS. I will not post photos of VBS children on my personal social media pages.

• Wear my VBS shirt every day with modest length shorts

• Teach children to lead by being a leader and setting an example. I will walk safely, calmly and quietly as I move from place to place. I will treat all adult leaders, visitors, other youth helpers, and of course the children, with respect. I will make sure the words I use and the way I use them are polite and Christhonoring.

• Report all concerns to the VBS coordinator if anything comes up.

• Remember that game time is for the youth. I will not roughhouse or distract children from the VBS activities that others are leading.

• I will become familiar with the theme for VBS and my role. I will ask an adult leader for clarification if needed.

• Come to VBS with a positive attitude, energy, and enthusiasm. I will arrive on time and check in with the teen coordinator to give my cell phone and check out with them after all campers have left.

- Comply with all policies and procedures of the church and requests of VBS coordinator
- Eat teen snacks at the correct time and only eat snacks that are designated for teens

I understand that being a teen leader at VBS is an honor and a gift. If I choose to not follow the commitments I have made above I understand a VBS leader or Holy Spirit staff member may ask me to leave.
