Blessed Rosalie Rendu (1786–1856), a Daughter of Charity, devoted her life to serving the poor in post-Revolutionary Paris. Often referred to as the "Mother of the Poor", her compassionate work in the slums of Paris inspired Frédéric Ozanam, a young law student, who sought her guidance in founding the Society of St. Vincent de Paul in 1833 as a way to put faith into action. Rosalie taught the Vincentians to serve with love, humility, and respect for human dignity, emphasizing personal encounters with the poor.

Beatified by Pope John Paul II in 2003, Blessed Rosalie's heroic charity and humility continue to inspire all called to serve Christ in the most vulnerable.


