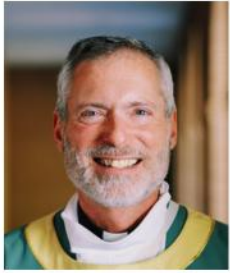

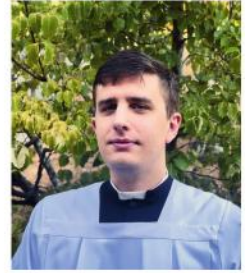

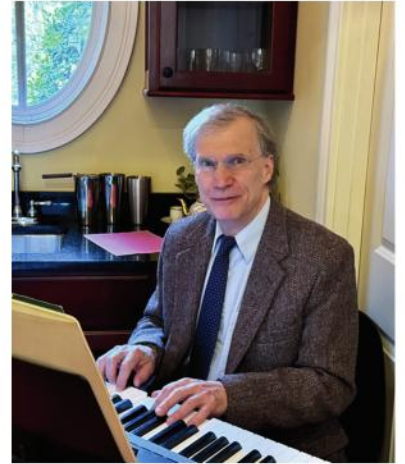
Start the New Year with Health Tips for Older Adults - Lunch and Learn

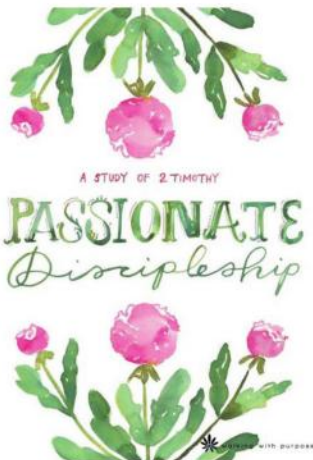
Find Hope and Healing: Grief Support Program This Spring

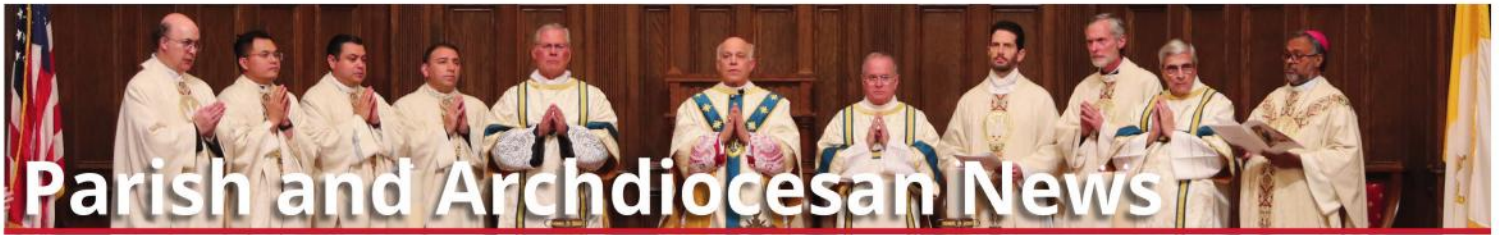
