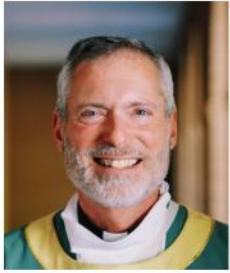

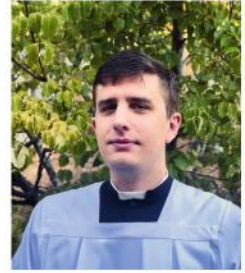

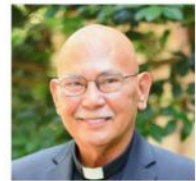

Join FIDELES to deepen your devotion to Jesus through the intercession of His Blessed Mother, and be part of a community dedicated to spiritual growth and fellowship.

FIDELES is a growing network of prayer groups for men with a special devotion to Jesus and His Blessed Mother. Inspired by an Atlanta man's unique prayer relationship with Mary, FIDELES aims to foster a deep and meaningful relationship with Jesus through Mary. This journey is beautifully documented in "The Conversation," a guide that serves as a cornerstone for FIDELES members.

The Latin name FIDELES translates to "The Faithful Ones" in English, a name given by Mary during inspired reflection. To be a faithful one means commitment to Jesus, Salvation, and the Church.

Meetings and Devotions

FIDELES members meet weekly to pray the rosary, followed by a period of meditation. Each member is committed to daily prayer, leading to profound rewards: a deepening of faith, a desire to become a better person, and the joy of sharing faith with others.
