## This Week's Scripture

*"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." - Matthew 11:28*

## An exercise for this week:

## God's Healing Grace: Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick Offered NEXT Saturday, July 11

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be offered on Saturday, July 11, after the 5:00 PM Mass in the Church. The anointing of the sick can be administered to a member of the faithful who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age. This sacrament can be repeated if the sick person, having recovered, again becomes gravely ill or if the condition becomes more grave during the same illness. Typically, the sacrament can be repeated annually for those in old age.

## Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) Class Forming



### Interested in becoming Catholic?

We are now enrolling for the next session of O.C.I.A. which will begin on Sunday August 9 and conclude on Sunday November 22, with reception into full communion with

the Roman Catholic Church at the 5:00 PM Vigil Mass on Saturday November 21. The class will meet on Sunday mornings at 10:00 AM, with Mass offered either before or after at 8:30 AM or 11:30 AM. Class will not meet on Labor Day, Columbus Day, or Thanksgiving weekends. A nominal fee of \$35 is required to register for the course; this fee helps cover the cost of books and other materials.

Because acceptance into the program requires pastoral approval, prospective O.C.I.A. participants should begin gathering sacramental documents, including, if applicable, certificates of baptism and marriage.
