These screenings typically aren't part of annual check-ups, and insurance may not cover them unless you're symptomatic. Stroke Scan Plus offers all seven ultrasound screenings (Stroke, AAA, Thyroid, Liver, Kidneys, and Gallbladder) for \$169. Blood tests incur an additional fee. 
# Fish Frys Hosted By the Knights of Columbus


