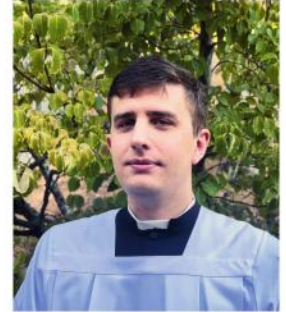

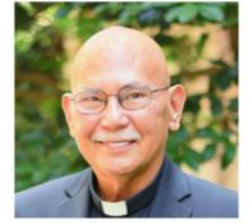

Stroke Scan will conduct preventive exams on Saturday, March 22, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM in rooms 16 and 17 at Centro Católico, under McDonough Hall. If you have high blood pressure, high cholesterol, diabetes, or a family history of heart disease or cancer, take advantage of this opportunity for early detection. These screenings typically aren't part of annual check-ups, and insurance may not cover them unless you're symptomatic. Stroke Scan Plus offers all seven ultrasound screenings (Stroke, AAA, Thyroid, Liver, Kidneys, and Gallbladder) for \$169. Blood tests incur an additional fee. ## Vuelve Stroke Scan Para Exames de Prevencion

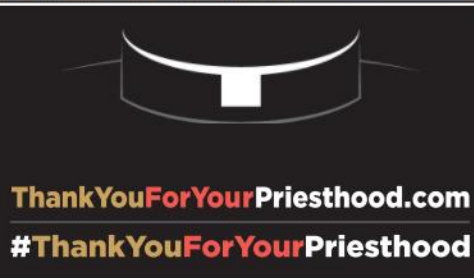
