
Helping Neighbors Find Stability





Únase a nuestra familia parroquial esta Cuaresma para Pray40: The Way mientras meditamos sobre los escritos de San Josemaría Escrivá, autor del clásico espiritual Camino.

"La Cuaresma es un tiempo de penitencia, purificación y conversión. No es un programa fácil, pero el cristianismo no es una forma de vida fácil. No es suficiente simplemente estar en la Iglesia, dejando que los años pasen. En nuestra vida, en la vida de los cristianos, nuestra primera conversión... es ciertamente muy significativa. Pero las conversiones posteriores son aún más importantes y cada vez más exigentes". - San Josemaría Escrivá

Escucharemos el poderoso consejo y la dirección espiritual de Escrivá cobrando vida a través de la historia en el Siervo de Dios Takashi Nagai, un japonés católico converso que sobrevivió milagrosamente al bombardeo atómico de Nagasaki en 1945. 
