We don't pay bills blindly. We pay vendors directly—and only after the neighbor contributes what they can. Our goal is not dependency, but stability and shared responsibility.


Research shows that timely emergency assistance dramatically reduces the risk of homelessness. More importantly, it restores dignity and hope.

Archbishop's Annual Appeal







Reflexión de la semana:
