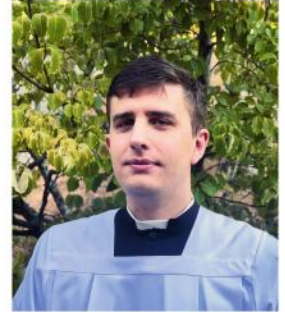

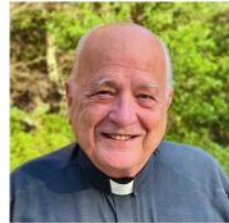

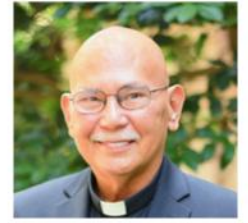

Stroke Scan Returns: Life-Saving Screenings on March 22

Stroke Scan will conduct preventive exams on Saturday, March 22, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM in rooms 16 and 17 at Centro Católico, under McDonough Hall. If you have high blood pressure, high cholesterol, diabetes, or a family history of heart disease or cancer, take advantage of this opportunity for early detection. These screenings typically aren't part of annual check-ups, and insurance may not cover them unless you're symptomatic. Stroke Scan Plus offers all seven ultrasound screenings (Stroke, AAA, Thyroid, Liver, Kidneys, and Gallbladder) for \$169. Blood tests incur an additional fee. Insurance is not necessary, and appointments are limited.

Vuelve Stroke Scan Para Exames de Prevencion

El 22 de marzo Stroke Scan Plus realizará exámenes preventivos vasculares con ultrasonido en los salones 15, 16 y 17 del Centro. Se examinarán dos áreas del cuerpo (Paquete Vascular): las arterias carótidas del cuello en busca de placas de grasa, lo cual es la causa número uno de derrames cerebrales; la aorta abdominal baja en busca de aneurismas. Estos exámenes cuestan regularmente, en los hospitales, entre \$500 a \$1,200 cada uno, Stroke Scan los ofrecerá por una fracción del costo Como cortesía, junto con el Paquete Vascular, también se examinarán la tiroides, hígado, vesícula y riñones, sin ningún costo adicional. Si usted quiere beneficiarse de estos exámenes Stroke Scan estará aquí en la iglesia el sábado 22 de marzo de 9 AM hasta las 4:00 PM. Año Santo Jubilar

2025 es el Año Santo Jubilar, el 2025 aniversario de la Encarnación de Nuestro Señor. El concepto de "Jubileo" tiene su origen en el Libro de Levítico (capítulo 25) y significa un año especial de reconciliación, peregrinación y regreso a casa. El Papa Francisco ha designado este Año Santo como un tiempo para renovarnos como "Peregrinos de la Esperanza". Como parte del Año Santo Jubilar, el Arzobispo Gregory J. Hartmayer, OFM Conv., ha anunciado que varias iglesias de la arquidiócesis servirán como iglesias locales de peregrinación.
