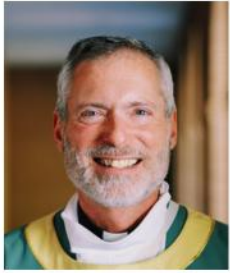

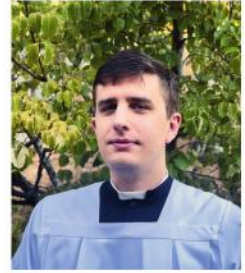

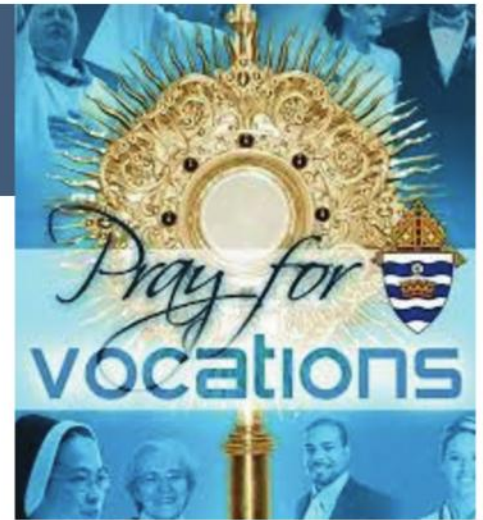
## 31 Club

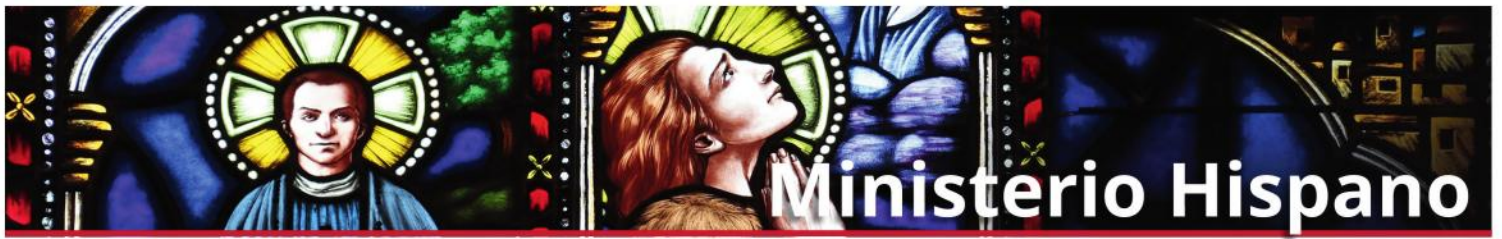
