#### Homeless Ministry

Join us in serving our homeless brothers and making a meaningful impact in our community. Whatever you can do, we are grateful.

The Homeless Ministry at Holy Spirit Catholic Church provides nourishment and support to homeless men who stay overnight in the basement of the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception downtown. The shelter operates during the winter months, from November 1st through March 31st. Our ministry serves dinner and provides breakfast and lunch bags on select nights during the shelter season. Members of the ministry prepare food at home, which is then transported and served by volunteers at the Shrine Shelter. This direct act of service embodies the teachings of the Gospel, where Jesus calls us to care for those in need:

"For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in,
I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me,
I was in prison and you came to visit me."
- Matthew 25:35-36

Our ministry offers a profound way to live out our faith by directly serving those in need. Volunteers find fulfillment in providing essential support and building connections with the men at the shelter. This ministry not only addresses physical hunger but also fosters a sense of community and compassion.


## 1 Million households in Georgia use more than 50% of their income for housing

Recently we helped a neighbor, who was out of work because of a broken ankle. His wife's salary was not enough to cover expenses for this family of 5. We visited them in their home to understand their needs, provided emergency rental assistance and referrals for food. Landlords require full payment upon the due date, immediately add late fees and start eviction processes. Georgia's eviction process can move quickly, potentially taking just a few weeks from the time rent is overdue to the actual eviction.


