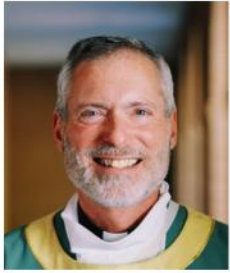

Altar Server Ministry

Serve at the altar, deepen your faith, and become a leader in our parish community. As an Altar Server, you'll grow closer to the Eucharist, gain a greater appreciation for the Mass, and help lead others in worship.

Altar Servers learn to actively participate in the Mass and deepen their reverence and appreciation for the liturgy. This ministry helps them to grow in their faith and understanding of the Church's traditions. Elite Altar Servers further develop leadership skills and demonstrate responsibility as they take on roles guiding and mentoring their peers by committing to service throughout high school.

Altar Servers are typically assigned to serve at 1-2 Masses per month. Beyond the weekly Mass schedule, they may also be invited to assist at special liturgies, including Holy Day Masses, First Communion, and Confirmation Masses, contributing to the spiritual milestones of their fellow parishioners.

All Altar Servers are trained to perform their duties proficiently. Training sessions are held quarterly. The next training is on Sunday, December 1, at 3:00 PM in the Church. Contact Deacon Underwood to attend. Prospective servers must have received their First Communion to be eligible to join this ministry.

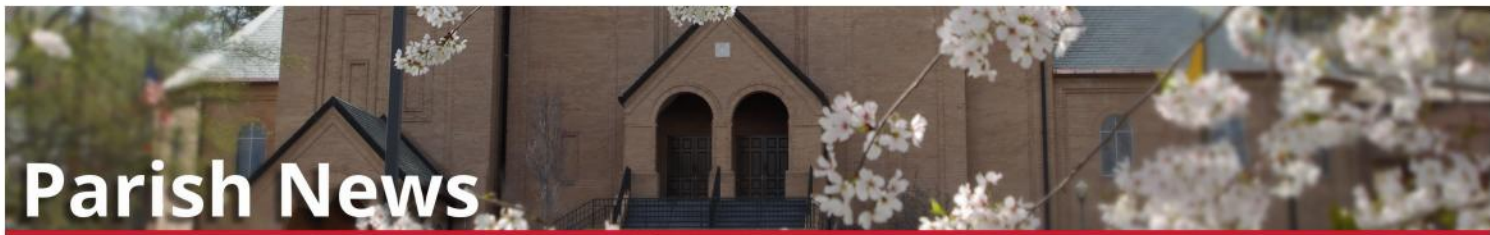

"To recite the Rosary is in fact to contemplate with Mary the face of Christ," in Pope St. John Paul II's words. The Rosary's power is well-recognized. And whenever we pray it, it's inspiring to know that fellow Catholics around the world are also doing so.

Did you know that the first half of the Hail Mary comes from the Gospel of St. Luke, and the second half is the Church's recognition of Mary's greatness and our plea for assistance for all of us?

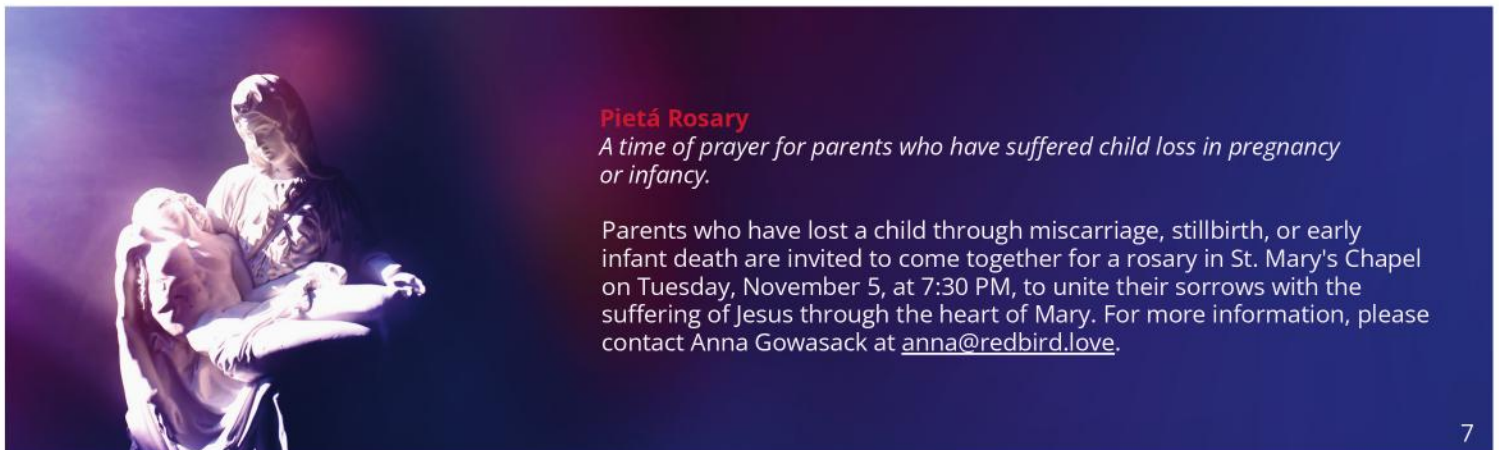
Conflicting Views of Fidelity: Join the Great Books Discussion Group

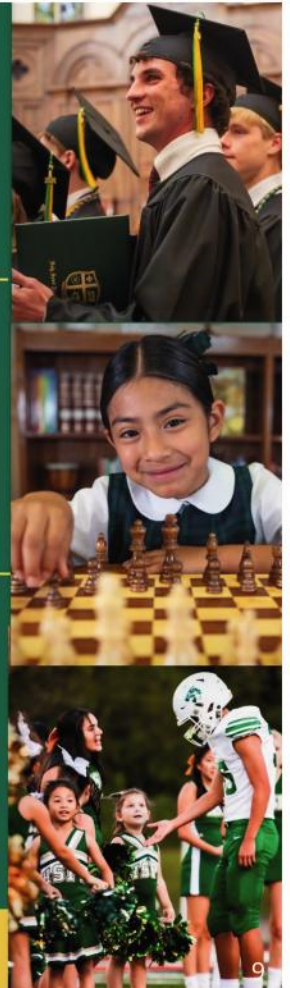
