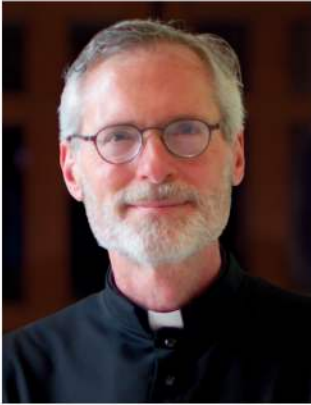

Meet Our Pastoral Seminarian Quinton Tran

Can you tell us a little about yourself and where you're from?

I was born in Atlanta and raised in Lawrenceville. I attended Gwinnett County Public Schools and received much of my Christian formation at Holy Vietnamese Martyrs Catholic Church. I was raised Catholic but had difficulty connecting with my faith until college, when I encountered the person of Jesus through a small group Bible study. That encounter changed my life forever!

I am Vietnamese and the eldest son of immigrant parents. I grew up with my grandparents, and I believe my vocation is owed in large part to the prayers of my late grandmother. I also have one younger brother who is my best friend.

What are you most looking forward to during your time at our parish?

It's providential that I have been assigned to Holy Spirit for pastoral year. I felt a particular closeness with the Holy Spirit develop this past summer when I was doing hospital chaplaincy. He was present with me, especially in my encounters with patients. I am looking forward to seeing how he has already been working the lives of parishioners, and I hope to support the work that he is doing.

How can our parish community best support you?

Pray! I am looking forward to how God will be forming me this year, but I also know that I will run into challenges. Please pray that I may be open to the challenges the Lord is offering me, that I may be aware of his presence in those moments, and that I may offer everything back to him for his greater glory. In simple terms, please pray that I may be a holy priest!

Also, please don't hesitate to reach out even if it's just to say hi! I want to get to know you as well as your relationship with God, no matter where you are in your journey. I'm convinced that God is walking with all of us on a great adventure.

What are some of your favorite hobbies or things you enjoy doing in your free time?

In my free time, I enjoy playing tennis, reading literature, and singing. In seminary, I really enjoyed being in the choir. I also love karaoke.

What advice would you give to someone who might be discerning a vocation?

"Do not be afraid." Pray and learn to encounter Jesus as a friend, especially in Eucharistic Adoration. Also, reach out to someone such as one of the priests, a vocations director, or a seminarian. One cannot discern alone, and one cannot discern without taking action. Ask Jesus what step he wants you to take next. He has a way of transforming our fears and revealing to us our deepest desires.



September 27: The Feast of St. Vincent de Paul — Inspired by His Compassion, Serving Neighbors Around the World



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St. Vincent de Paul dedicated his life to serving people experiencing poverty, becoming an enduring inspiration to generations of Vincentians. In 1833, 22-year-old Frédéric Ozanam and his companions founded the Society of St. Vincent de Paul in Paris, placing their work in the spirit of St. Vincent's commitment to direct, person-to-person service.

Today, that mission reaches **155 countries**, with more than **800,000 Vincentians** serving through approximately **48,000 local Conferences** (parishes). Together, they assist more than **30 million** people every single day.

First Communicant Parent Meeting TODAY

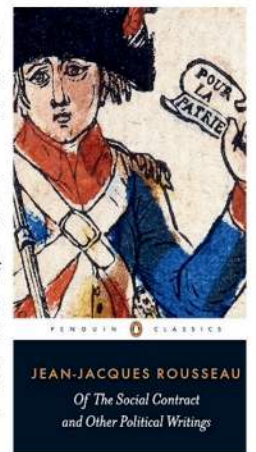

Jean-Jacques Rousseau (1712–1778) was a gifted musician, writer, and philosopher whose ideas profoundly shaped Western political thought. Some of his writings were so controversial that France and Switzerland banned them as threats to civil and religious authority.

At the next Great Books Discussion Group meeting, we'll discuss Rousseau's *The Social Contract* (1762), in which he argues that sovereignty ultimately belongs to the people. The work would go on to influence generations of philosophers, thinkers, and revolutionaries. The group meets Thursday, October 8, at 7:00 PM in McDonough Hall, Side B. 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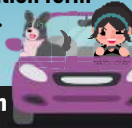
