Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I am pleased to share with you the Financial Report for the parish for the 2017-2018 fiscal year.

First, my thanks to you all for what you have done and what you continue to do – we are blessed to have so many active and devoted parishioners.

As you can see from the attached Report, our revenues were down for the year and our expenses were up. Despite these challenges, due to careful stewardship and the continued generosity of our parishioners, we were able to increase our savings and grow our Endowment slightly.

Our revenues are down in the past year primarily due to a decrease in electronic giving of approximately 3.5%. Our hope is that anyone who ceased electronic giving in the past year will prayerfully consider reinstating it. If the change in the system for electronic giving caused you to stop participating, please call the parish office – we will be more than happy to assist you in navigating the new system.

Although our overall giving was down, there are many positive signs. Our brothers and sisters at Centro Católico increased their offertory giving by more than 35%. In addition, you all contributed over \$320,000 to worthy organizations including the St. Vincent de Paul Society, the Buckhead Christian Ministry, and others as requested in the archdiocesan special collections. You also exceeded last year's goal for the Archbishop's Annual Appeal, and the overage directly helped our parish programs and helped grow the Endowment for the benefit of our parish.

Our increased expenses are a good thing, as we have put your generous gifts to good use – we have increased our staff devoted to religious education, young adults' ministry, and in the Hispanic Mission. We hope to continue to increase our expenses as our parish grows and we are able to help more and more people in our parish and beyond.

Thank you all again for all you have done and all you continue to do to support our work at Holy Spirit. It is only through the continuing generosity of our parishioners that we can do His work in our parish and in the greater Atlanta community.
